

Makahiki 2015 Scout Games - Aloha Council - Oahu

Scout Knots & Sled Pull



This game demonstrates Scout Knots and teamwork. The score is the shortest adjusted elapsed time as adjusted for knot tying accuracy. Each team consists of three scouts that will tie together several chords of rope and cordage to create a harness to a cardboard sled as instructed by the Scout Commissioner. Once the sled is secured the team will have two “pullers” and one “rider” and must complete a marked course. The Scout Commissioner will record the elapsed time at the finish line and inspect the completed harness for the correct knots and add time additions for every improperly tied knot. The course must be completed without any knot failures. If any knots fail on the course the team must go back to the starting line and re-tie the failed knot and start again while the original time is running. Aloha Council will provide all of the materials for the event.

Firemaking & Pancake Toss



This game demonstrates Scout Fire making skills, Scout Cooking Skills and teamwork. The score is the shortest adjusted time. Each team consists of three scouts. The first scout will light a propane gas stove by starting a fire using a BSA magnesium “Hot Spark” and steel bar to light a matchstick. The second scout will heat a frying pan and completely cook a pancake without utensils (incomplete cooking of the pancake will result in penalty time added). The third scout will run a course with the frying pan & pancake and “flip it” over a suspended clothesline, run back to the other two scouts and the three scouts will divide the pancake and eat it. Once the scouts have eaten the pancake they will present themselves to the Scout Commissioner standing at attention with Scout sign to complete the game. All materials will be provided by Aloha Council.

First Aid & Transport



This game demonstrates Scout First Aid Skills and teamwork. The score is the shortest adjusted time. Each team will consist of 5 scouts; four scouts to administer first aid and one “patient”. The team will address each type of first aid in series. One scout will apply an upper leg splint and an upper arm splint. The second scout will apply an arm sling to the affected arm and a head bandage. The third scout will apply a wound dressing on the calf (remaining free leg) and a ankle sprain bandage. The fourth scout will write an emergency note describing all of the injuries and run to deliver the note to the Scout Commissioner and then run back to the team. Once the Scout Commissioner reads the note he will signal for the team to carry the “patient” through a course using a stretcher made out of blue tarp and poles. Faulty first aid techniques will have added time penalties to the elapsed time. All materials will be provided by Aloha Council.
